

Technical Handbook

1. Competition Information

1.1. **Competition Dates** : 7 – 9 December 2018

1.2. Competition Venue

Multi Purpose Hall, Hassanal Bolkiah National Stadium Sports Complex, Berakas

2. Events

2.1. The karate competition will consist of four (4) events comprising the following two (2) men's and two (2) women's events:

3. Quotas

3.1. Individual Events: Each country may enter one (1) athlete only in each individual event.

3.2. Team Kata Events: Each country may enter one (1) Kata Team only per Team Kata event which is to comprise of three (3) male athletes for the Men Team Kata and three (3) female athletes for the Women's Team Kata event, both with no reserves.

4. Eligibility

4.1. All athletes competing in Karate shall be subject to the following age limitation.

4.1.1. The minimum age for Kata events is sixteen (16) years as at 7 December 2018. Born on or after 7 December 2002.

5. Submission of Entries

Entries of each participating Contingent must be submitted in accordance with the regulations laid down by the Brunei BIMPNT-EAGA 2018 Organising Committee.

5.1. Deadline for “Entry by Number”

Deadline for submission of Entry by Number Forms is **6th September 2018** @ 1700 hours BRUNEI time (GMT+8)

5.2. Deadline for “Entry by Name”

Deadline for submission of Entry by Name Forms is **7th November 2018** @ 1700 hours Brunei Time (GMT +8).

8. Training

8.1. Training Policies

- 8.1.1. Pre-competition training will be allocated to all Contingents two (2) days prior to the start of the competition for the sports (including familiarisation, if necessary). Training sessions are strictly by allocation; no change and addition of training requests are allowed. Contingents are required to notify the Sport Information Desk if any Contingent does not intend to use the allocated training session.
- 8.1.2. Pre-competition training shall be starting from 5th December 2018 and ending on 6th December 2018 (2 days).
- 8.1.3. Every Contingent is designated with a training area fully equipped with Tatami, and the training sessions are according to the schedule.
- 8.1.4. There will be no designated training area during the competition day.

8.3.2. Training during Competition

There will be no designated training area during competition days.

8.4. Equipment at Training Venue

Training venues will be fully equipped with Tatami.

9. Competition Procedures, Rules and Regulations

9.1. Competition Rules

The Karate competition of the BIMPNT-EAGA 2018 will be held in accordance with the BIMPNT-EAGA Charter and Rules and the current World Karate Federation (WKF) Rules and Regulations.

In case of any disagreement in the language interpretation of the WKF Rules and regulations, the English version shall prevail. Any unforeseen cases not covered by the Rules and Regulations shall be resolved as follows:

9.1.1. General Issues: To be resolved in accordance with the BIMPNT-EAGA Charter and Rules.

9.1.2. Technical Issues: To be resolved in accordance with the WKF Rules and Regulations and WKF Norms.

9.2. Competition Format

The Karate competition will be conducted on a single elimination with repechage format.

9.3. Official Draw

The Official Draw for Karate will be conducted in accordance with WKF Rules and Regulations during the Team Managers' Meeting.

9.4. Delays, postponements or cancellations

The Technical Delegate must consult the BIMPNT-EAGA Secretariat if there is any delay, postponement or cancellation of any competition that affects the scheduled times for victory ceremonies.

10. Sports equipment and Competition attire

10.1. Sports equipment

All sports equipment used by athletes in competition must comply with the BIMPNT-EAGA Charter and Rules and WKF Rules and Regulations.

10.2. Competition attire

- 10.2.1. All attire worn by athletes in competition must comply with the BIMPNT-EAGA Charter and Rules and WKF Rules and Regulations.
- 10.2.2. Coaches shall be properly attired in their official Contingent Track suit and display their official identification and in accordance with the BIMPNT-EAGA Charter and Rules.
- 10.2.3. All coaches officiating in medal bouts shall wear a dark colour suit with tie according to WKF norm and in accordance with the BIMPNT-EAGA Charter and Rules.

11. Technical Officials and Jury of Appeal

- 11.1. The appointments of Technical Officials and Jury of Appeal members will be in accordance with the BIMPNT-EAGA Charter and Rules.
- 11.2. Jury of Appeal
The TD will appoint a Jury of Appeal for the sport to comprise not less than three (3) members and not more than five (5) members (including a Chairperson) to hear any protest.

12. Protests and Appeals

- 12.1. Video review of bouts will be applied based on WKF Rules and Regulations and procedures.
- 12.2. Any written protest must be made and submitted by the Chef de Mission or Team Manager to the TD within sixty (60) minutes after the bout in which the protest is generated with the payment of a Protest Fee of BND 200.00 per protest.
- 12.3. Any protest must be heard and decided by the Jury of Appeal for the sport within two (2) hours after receipt of the written protest by the TD.
- 12.4. The protest fee shall be refunded if the protest is upheld; it will be forfeited if the protest is rejected.

13. Doping Control

- 13.1. BRUNEI Organizing Committee, under the guidance of the BIMPNT-EAGA Games Federation, will be responsible for the Anti-Doping Programme during the BIMPNT-EAGA Games, 2018. The Anti-Doping Programme will be implemented in accordance with BIMPNT-EAGA GF Anti-Doping Rules and the World Anti-Doping Code and its relevant International Standards.

- 13.2. Doping Control stations will be set up at the competition venue, where in-competition testing will be conducted. The Test Distribution Plan and criteria for athlete selection for each sport will comply with the Doping Control protocol established by the BIMPNT-EAGA GF and BIMPNT-EAGA OC.
- 13.3. Doping Control procedures will be implemented according to WADA's International Standards for Testing and Investigations. Sample analysis will be performed at a WADA-accredited laboratory.
- 13.4. An athlete identified for doping testing should be accompanied by a team official for the entire testing process.

14. Victory Ceremony

- 14.1. Victory Ceremonies will be held in accordance with the BIMPNT-EAGA GF Charter and Rules to honour the individual and team achievements of the winning athletes.
- 14.2. The athletes who have been judged first, second and third shall take their places, in their sport attire or Contingent designated attire, on a stand facing the Tribune of Honour, with the winner slightly above the second who is on his/her right, and the third who is on his/her left.
