Technical Handbook

1. COMPETITON INFORMATION

1.1. DATE

The 10th BimpNT-Eaga Friendship Games, Brunei Darussalam 2018 will be held from 7th Dec, 2018 to 9th Dec, 2018.

1.2. VENUE

1.2.1. Competition Site

Youth Centre, Bandar Seri Begawan

1.2.2. Training Sites

Training Venues will be facilitated allowing the competing teams to train before and during the competition.

1.3. EVENTS

The competition comprises the following events:

- 1.3.1. Tunggal (single) Category Open Category
 - i. Male
 - ii. Female
- 1.3.2. Tunggal (single) Category Compulsory Movement
 - i. Male
 - ii. Female
- 1.3.3. Ganda (double) Category
 - i. Male
 - ii. Female
- 1.3.4. Regu (team) Category Compulsory Movement
 - i. Male
 - ii. Female

2. RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 2.1. The competition rules and regulations shall be carried out in accordance with the rules and regulations set by the International Pencak Silat Federation (PERSILAT) Year 2012, version 30/08/2013.
- 2.2. The scoring system for the competition will be done manually.
- 2.3. Any unsettled decisions or problems that arise which are not stated in the PERSILAT competition rules and regulations will be resolved by the Organizing Committee. The Organizing Committee's decision will be final.
- 2.4. Technical Officials will reiterate the rules and regulations to the Team Manager a day prior to the start of competition.

3. SILAT UNIFORM

- 3.1. The athletes for Tunggal (Single) and Ganda (Double) category should wear the silat uniform in a plain color, with the accessories (Ikat Kepala / Songkok and Kain Samping).
- 3.2. The Athletes for Regu (Team) must wear a standard black Pencak Silat uniform, with a white belt of 10cm that is wrapped not tight nor loosely and also without accessories.

4. COMPETITION RULES FOR TUNGGAL (SINGLE), GANDA (DOUBLE) AND REGU (TEAM) CATEGORY

TIMES FOR EVERY CATERGORY:

- 4.1. For Tunggal (Single) category, Ganda (Double) category and Regu (Team) category, the performance time is for 3 (three) minutes.
- 4.2. All athletes who have the queue number to perform but fail to be present after three (3) times their names have been called by the Technical Official, will be disqualified.
- 4.3. The exception to this is only if athletes encounter any problems due to technical issues arising from the Organizers. The Technical Official shall resolve this in the best interest of both parties, and the result will be final.

5. PERFORMANCE SYNOPSES FOR GANDA (DOUBLE) CATEGORY

All team managers and/or coaches are required to give a synopsis for their athletes' performances (in cases of dropping of the weapons) to the Technical Official before performing.

5.1. WEAPONS DROPPING AND ACCESSORY

For Tunggal (Single) / Ganda (Double) category, if the weapons used by the athlete drops, and this is not part of the synopsis given to the Technical Officials, the points will be deducted. In Ganda (Double) category, when any accessory drops off, this will be excused. But, for the Tunggal (Single) and Regu (Team) category, points will be deducted for each mistake.

5.2. **WEAPONS**

5.2.1. Tunggal (Single) Category Long Knife (Golok or Parang) size 30cm – 40cm Toya / Tongkat (Rod) made from rattan (measurements from 150cm to 180cm and diameter of 2.5cm – 3.5cm).

5.2.2. Ganda (Double) Category

Besides the weapons mentioned above, in Ganda (Double) category, the athletes are allowed to use weaponry such as golok, toya, keris, pisau, celurit and trisula as stated in the Competition Rules of the International Pencak Silat Federation (PERSILAT).

All team managers and coaches are required to show all the weapons and get clarification form the Technical Officials during the Tunggal and Ganda category briefing. If the weapons are denied by the Technical Official, the team managers and coaches must ensure their athletes will not be using them during the competition. If they fail to do so, the participants will be disqualified by the Technical Official.

6. ATHLETES ORDER

Athletes must be ready one (1) party before the category which they will be competing in starts. All athletes are also advised to follow all the instructions from the officer in charge.

7. COMPETTITONS ANNOUNCEMENT (RESULT)

The announcement of the result for every competition will be announced after each category finishes.

8. TECHNICAL OFFICIALS

- 8.1. The competition will be conducted by PERSILAT Referee and Juror holding the International Certificate or Individual Country Referee Certificate.
- 8.2. All results made by the panel of Referees and Jurors are final.

9. PROTESTS

- 9.1. A request for the 'Protest Form' must be made within 10 minutes after result of the competition has been announced; and within the following 20 minutes, the completed form must be returned to the head of Competition including a protest fee of BND 200.00 in cash (Brunei Dollar Two Hundred Only).
- 9.2. The protest fee will be refunded to the team manager if the protest appeal is accepted and approved by the appeal Committee. However, should the protest appeal be unsuccessful, the protest fee will be forfeited.

10. PROTOCOL ETIQUETTE & DISCIPLINE

The etiquette & Discipline for attire during the 10th BIMPNT-EAGA Friendship Games, Brunei Darussalam 2018 are as follows:

- 10.1. During Opening Ceremony / Closing Ceremony Official tracksuit or standard silat attire
- 10.2. During Prize Presentation Official tracksuit or standard silat attire
- 10.3. During Competition Artistic event– according to the Rules & Regulations of PERSILAT
- 10.4. THE DISCIPLINE OF CEREMONIES & COMPETITION:
 - 10.4.1. Participants must be present at every ceremony and event on time, according to the schedule set by the Organizer.
 - 10.4.2. Participants must maintain good personal appearance and perform with good attitude and spirit of sportsmanship.
 - 10.4.3. Participants must follow any ceremony in an orderly manner, and must not utter any noise which might cause disruption to the ceremony.
 - 10.4.4. Disciplinary action will be taken towards athletes' improper conduct or bad behaviour.
 - 10.4.5. No abusive and vulgar language / words are to be used at all times.
 - 10.4.6. No indecent hand gestures and signs at all times (e.g middle finger, etc).

11. RULES AND CONDITIONS

- 11.1. International rules and regulations for each type of sport to be contested will apply.
- 11.2. Each athlete is allowed to participate in three (3) individual events only.
- 11.3. Athletes must be 21 years old and below on the championship date (born on or after 7th December 1997).
- 11.4. Athletes must be amateur-friendly and must not have previous participation in regional and international sports such as SEA Games, ASIAN Games and others.
- 11.5. Each athlete shall hold the nationality of the country he / she represents.
